Pattern Dances for the 2014/2015 Season

All skaters, coaches and officials are advised that the Pattern Dances to be skated for the 2014/2015 season are as follows:

Ice Dance

Elementary – Group 3 – Dutch Waltz, Swing Dance

Pre-Primary – Group 3 – Fiesta Tango, Foxtrot

Primary - ISU Basic Novice - Foxtrot and American Waltz

Novice - ISU Advanced Novice

Local, <u>State/National Competitions and State Championships</u> – Rocker Foxtrot, Starlight Waltz

National Championships - European Waltz, Tango

Music requirements for Pattern Dances for Ice Dance

The current series of ISU Dance Music shall be used for the Pattern Dances, with the following **exceptions** where couples <u>are to provide their own music</u>.

Primary – Foxtrot

Novice - Tango and Starlight Waltz

The music chosen must be in accordance with the Rhythm of the Pattern Dance. The tempo throughout the required Sequences must be constant and in accordance with the required tempo of the Pattern Dance plus or minus 2 beats per minute.

The chosen music may be a tune from the ISU Ice Dance music. In this case, only tunes 1 to 5 can be chosen and the Couple shall furnish the competition music.

The music provided by the Couple, the start of the first Step of the dance must be on beat 1 of a measure (unless otherwise specified in the description of the dance).
