Pattern Dances for the 2013/2014 Season

All skaters, coaches and officials are advised that the Pattern Dances to be skated for the 2013/2014 season are as follows:

Ice Dance

Elementary – Group 2 – Dutch Waltz, Fiesta Tango

Pre-Primary - Group 2 - Swing Dance, European Waltz

Primary – as per ISU Communication 1760 – Basic Novice – Fourteenstep and European Waltz

Novice – as per ISU Communication 1760 – Advanced Novice

Local, State and National Competitions - European Waltz, Kilian

National Championships - Tango, Blues

Music requirements for Pattern Dances for Ice Dance – as per ISU Communication 1782

The current series of ISU Dance Music shall be used for the Pattern Dances, with the following exceptions where couples are to provide their own music.

Primary - Fourteenstep

Novice - Kilian and Tango

The music chosen must be in accordance with the Rhythm of the Pattern Dance. The tempo throughout the required Sequences must be constant and in accordance with the required tempo of the Pattern Dance plus or minus 2 beats per minute.

The chosen music may be a tune from the ISU Ice Dance music. In this case, only tunes 1 to 5 can be chosen and the Couple shall furnish the competition music.

The music provided by the Couple, the start of the first Step of the dance must be on beat 1 of a measure (unless otherwise specified in the description of the dance).

Solo Dance - Group 4

Elementary - Fiesta Tango

Pre-Primary – Foxtrot

Primary - Tango

Open - Kilian

Adult - Fiesta Tango
