Age Changes - Novice B Singles and Intermediate Levels

All Skaters, Coaches, Officials and Competition Organisers are advised the following changes will take place with **IMMEDIATE EFFECT** as approved at the recent 2016 ISA AGM.

- Novice B Singles (previously referred to as Primary Singles) changes initiated are to align with ISU Regulations.
- Intermediate Singles Ladies and Men
- All skaters, coaches, officials, and competition organisers are advised of the following <u>age changes</u> as a result of the recent 2016 ISA AGM.

Novice B Singles: (previously referred to as Primary Singles) -

As per ISU Age requirements (Rule 108, paragraph 3. c) and paragraph 4. c)): In International Competitions, a Novice is a Skater who has met the following requirements before July 1st preceding the event (the specific date: before July 1st, applies to all indicated dates): <u>has not reached the age of fifteen (15) for Single Skating</u>

Intermediate Singles: has reached the age of fifteen (15) as at 1 July.

• changes initiated are to raise the lower Intermediate age requirement to align with revised Basic Novice B upper age limit

ISA By Laws:
