1 Purpose of the Communication

The world is currently experiencing a COVID-19 virus epidemic. This Communication provides guidance and the position of ISA for parents, coaches, athletes and officials

2 Application of the Communication

This communication applies to all skating athletes, parents, officials and coaches.

3 Communication Statement

Due to the current inability for athletes to train and prepare for competition/tests, ISA recognises that the opportunity to qualify for competition is severely affected. As such, ISA will be reviewing the current method of qualification, including Tests. Given the likelihood that some Champ Series events (previously known as Benchmark events) may or may not go ahead. It is however too early to make the appropriate changes to Policy until a timeline as to when ice rinks will reopen is advised by the Government. We want to assure you that your concerns are foremost in our minds. The Champ Series events are conducted primarily by our Member States. ISA wants to ensure there is a cohesive approach to any changes that come about and will be working closely with Member States once the reopening date of ice rinks is known.

Be assured that figure skating will be back and you should continue to stay well, keep fit and ready to get back on the ice.
