## **1** Purpose of the Communication

In ISU Communication 2316, it is stated that the upper age limit for Novice and Junior Synchronized Skaters for the 2020-2021 season has been raised by one year. Accordingly, ISA will also increase its upper age limit for these divisions for the same period with the same stipulations.

## 2 Application of the Communication

All Novice and Junior Synchronized Skating Teams for any competition/championship in and out of Australia.

## 3 Communication Statement

This extended age limit applies only for Novice and Junior Synchronized Skating Teams that were already competing together during the 2019/20 season and in cases where the same programs as for season 2019/20 are maintained. If a Junior or Novice Team changes Skater(s), the new Skater(s) must be of the Junior/Novice age according to Rule 108, paragraph 4 of the 2018 ISU General Regulations.

Australian Novice and Junior Ice Synchronized Teams opting for such extension of the Novice or Junior upper age limit must send a request via the relevant State Association to the Chair of the ISA Synchronized Skating Committee (<u>synchronized@isa.org.au</u>) in order to obtain permission for the exception for the Team concerned. The request must give the Team name, Skater's name and date of birth; and which competitions the Skater was registered in

The skater must have been registered in the team list for the 2019 AFSC or an international competition/championship in the 2019-2020 season.
