1 Purpose of the Communication

Many Elementary skaters are currently executing level 2/3 spins and they deserve to be given credit for these spins. This should make the transition into Basic Novice easier.

Step sequences are a concern to technical panels as many of the skaters are trying to get features and not focussing on clean turns in order to get at least a level one. The removal of clusters as a feature, therefore, should enable the skaters to focus on the quality of their turns in the step sequence. It is easy to get a level 2 with seven clean turns and rotations.

Elementary skaters will have features up to Level 2 called for spins and steps.

For elementary and preliminary skaters, clusters in the step sequence will no longer count as a feature for a level.
