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WELL BALANCED PROGRAM CONTENT SEASON 2015 – 2016

As per Rule 992 para 1 a) (Short Program) and Rule 992 para 1b) (Free Skating) the list of Program Content is listed below:

NOTE: The Base Value of the Elements will be the same for those Elements listed as either choice of one (1) Element (Adult and Basic Novice) or as a choice of one (1) Element shown within a Group (A, B and C)

Changes to Communication 1886 -part of Section 1.2 page 10 BASIC NOVICE A & B

1.2 Free Skating

Basic Novice A and B competitions will consist of a Free Skating program only.

A well-balanced Free Skating program must contain the following six (6) five (5) required elements plus one (1) of the optional elements:

- 1. **Intersection** Element (pi not counted)
- 2. Linear Element Line
- 3. **Pivoting** Element Block
- 4. **Rotating** Element Circle-Wheel
- 5. **Traveling** Element Wheel Circle
- 6. Choice of one (1) of the following optional elements:
 - Creative Element

OR

• Combined Element

Maximum element levels can be skated but the level awarded will be one level lower than the maximum defined in the ISU Technical Rules.

2.2 Free Skating

Advanced Novice competitions will consist of a Free Skating program only.

A well-balanced Free Skating program must contain the following seven (7) elements:

Must include the following six (6) five (5) required elements plus one (1) element from each of the groups A & B:

- 1. Intersection Element
- 2. Move Element
- 3. No Hold Element
- 4. **Pivoting** Element Block
- 5. Rotating Element Circle
- 5. **Traveling** Element Wheel Circle

PLUS a choice of one (1) Element from each of the following Groups

Group A

Rotating Element – Wheel

OR

<u>Linear Element – Line</u>

Group B Choice of one (1) of the following Elements:

• Creative Element

OR

• Combined Element

Maximum element levels can be skated but and the level awarded will be one level lower than the maximum will be called as executed. Maximum levels of Additional Features can be skated and will be rewarded according to the execution of the team.

The following information replaces ISU Communication 1873

ADULT (6 Elements)

MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING FIVE (5) REQUIRED ELEMENTS:

- 1. **Intersection** Element
- 2. Linear Element Line
- 3. **Pivoting** Element Block
- 4. **Rotating** Element Wheel
- 5. **Traveling** Element Circle

PLUS a choice of one (1) of the following Elements:

• Creative Element

OR

• Combined Element

JUNIOR SHORT (Five (5) Elements)

- 1. **Intersection** Element
 - Triangle Intersection
 - Additional Feature (point of intersection) is required
- 2. Move Element
 - fm's must be executed by all skaters at the same time
 - One (1) fm must be an unsupported spiral executed by at least ½ of the team
 - Any other fm(s) that the team wishes to include is a free choice of the team
 - A minimum of four (4) skaters must attempt an fm
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed
- 3. No Hold Element
 - block configuration (four (4) horizontal lines of four (4) skaters)
 - Additional Feature (Step Sequence) is required
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed
- 4. **Pivoting** Element Block
 - Pivoting executed in four (4) lines is required
 - One change of configuration is required (in any manner)
 - Change of configuration may be executed either before or after pivoting but not during
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed
- 5. **Traveling** Element Wheel
 - Travel in a three (3) spoke configuration is required
 - One change of configuration is required (in any manner)
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed

JUNIOR FREE (Eight (8) Elements)

MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING FIVE (5) REQUIRED ELEMENTS

- 1. **Intersection** Element
- 2. Move Element
- 3. No Hold Element
- 4. **Pivoting** Element Line
- 5. **Traveling** Element Circle

PLUS A Choice of one (1) Element from each of the following Groups

Group A

- Linear Element Block
- Rotating Element Wheel

Group B

- **Move** Element (if choosing to included a second ME from Group B then all fm (s) must be different than those executed in the required ME)
- Pair Element
- Synchronized Spin Element*

Group C

- Creative Element
- Combined Element

SENIOR SHORT (Five (5) Elements)

- 1. **Intersection** Element
 - Box Intersection
 - Additional Feature (point of intersection) is required
- 2. Move Element
 - fm's must be executed by all skaters at the same time
 - One (1) fm must be an unsupported spiral executed by at least ½ of the team
 - Any other fm(s) that the team wishes to include is a free choice of the team
 - A minimum of four (4) skaters must attempt an fm
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed

3. No Hold Element

- block configuration (four (4) horizontal lines of four (4) skaters)
- Additional Feature (Step Sequence) is required
- Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed
- 4. **Pivoting** Element Block
 - Pivoting executed in three (3) lines is required
 - One change of configuration is required (in any manner)
 - Change of configuration may be executed either before or after pivoting but not during
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed
- 5. **Traveling** Element Wheel
 - Travel in a three (3)-spoke configurations required
 - One change of configuration is required (in any manner)
 - Features are permitted and will be counted if correctly executed

SENIOR FREE (Ten (10) Elements)

MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING Seven (7) REQUIRED ELEMENTS

- 1. **Group Lift** Element
- 2. Two (2) Different Intersection Elements
- 3. Move Element
- 4. **No Hold** Element
- 5. **Pivoting** Element Line
- 6. **Traveling** Element Circle

PLUS A Choice of one (1) Element from each of the following Groups:

Group A

- Linear Element Block
- Rotating Element Wheel

Group B

- **Move** Element (if choosing the ME from Group B then all fm(s) must be different than those in the required ME)
- Pair Element
- Synchronized Spin Element*

Group C

- Creative Element
- Combined Element

*NOTE

The Synchronized Spin Element is being considered as a required element for the 2016 -2017 season
