1 Purpose of the Communication

In ISU Communication 2316, it is stated that the upper age limit for Novice and Junior Ice Dance for the 2020-2021 season has been raised by one year. Accordingly, ISA will also increase its upper age limit for these divisions for the same period with the same stipulations.

2 Application of the Communication

All Novice and Junior Ice Dance couples for any competition/championship in and out of Australia.

3 Communication Statement

This extended age limit applies only for Novice and Junior Ice Dance couples who were already competing together during the 2019/20 season and in cases where the same programs as for season 2019/20 are maintained.

Australian Novice and Junior Ice Dance couples opting for such extension of the Novice or Junior upper age limit must send a request via the relevant State Association to Ice Skating Australia (administration@isa.org.au) in order to obtain permission for the exception for the couple concerned. The request must give names of both skaters in the couple, both dates of birth; and which competitions the couple skated in during the 2019-2020 season.

The dance couple must have been registered for at least one competition/championship in the 2019-2020 season.
